¹ Non-Entry Workers - Workers who may be exposed to confined spaces due to their presence at the jobsite, but will not be participating in Permit-Required Confined Space entries as part of their current job duties.

² Reclassified Space Entry Workers - Workers who may participate in reclassified Permit-Required Confined Space entries. Permit-Required Confined Spaces may be reclassified to non-permit spaces through the documented elimination of all serious hazards. This Entry is the preferred confined space entry.

³ Permit Required Confined Spaced Entry Workers - Workers who may participate in Permit-Space entries where all serious hazards cannot be completely eliminated.
